GRIEF CAVE

2021-2022

A textile-based installation piece and communal healing space. Hanging fabric pieces make up the texture of the cave: stalactites and stalagmites made of cloth, memorabilia calcified over with crystals and growths, grottos and overhangs made of patchwork. Sound and lighting design help to create an immersive environment.

I originally created Grief Cave as a roving installation in the back of a Uhaul. It will also be shown at Hatch Gallery in Hamtramck May - June 2022.

LOST HORIZON NIGHT MARKET

2014-2018

Built out art experiences for a transient, nocturnal, recurring street art carnival in Brooklyn. Installations were built into the back of trailers or trucks, and varied from Rube Goldberg nacho-making machines to immersive game show simulations.

FLUX FACTORY HOTEL WARS

2015

Created costumes and floats for a series of community events in response to rezoning changes in Long Island City that allowed dozens of hotels to transform the neighborhood of Dutch Kills into a shifting environment of temporary visitors.
